

How to add AddTrustExternalCARoot.cer to HP device

For proper OptimiDoc Cloud functionality on HP devices you need to upload CA certificate into HP device via web interface.

Please follow instructions below:

1. Download from our partner portal AddTrustExternalCARoot.zip
2. Extract AddTrustExternalCARoot.zip file
3. Sign into HP device web interface as administrator
4. Go to Security bookmark
5. Click on Certificate Management in left sidebar.
6. Find CA Certificates section
7. Upload the certificate file AddTrustExternalCARoot.cer

CA Certificates

To validate server identity, install the certificate of the CA that issued the server certificate.

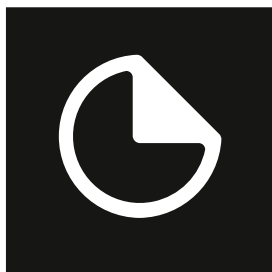
