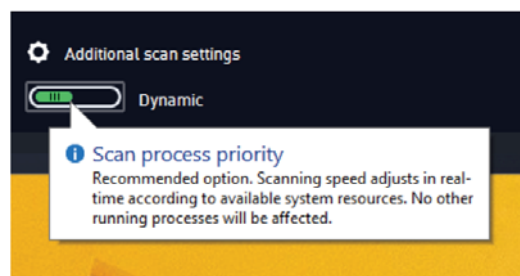
AVG Performance optimizations

AVG Business Editions include several additional features that maximize performance while maintaining the best possible protection.

Scheduling: maximize performance by scheduling scans to occur overnight. Easily change your preference in the Settings menu.

Smart Scanning: means that previously scanned files that are known to be “safe” and have not been touched, are excluded from subsequent scans– we call this Smart Scanning and it is defaulted to ON.

Dynamic Scanning: the Antivirus software automatically pauses whenever another application needs to run (let’s say you just opened a spreadsheet) and waits until the processor is again idle, and only then resumes the scan. Easily change your preference in the Scan Settings, this is defaulted to ON.



These advanced features all work together to help protect and maintain the performance of your computer.
