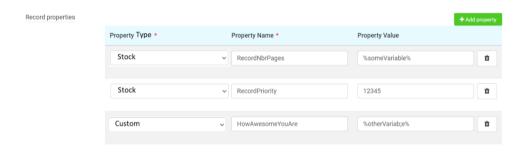

1 NEW FEATURES

Scanning documents into Micro Focus Content Manager version 9.x with metadata attached

Micro Focus Content Manager (formerly HP Content Manager, HP Trim) is an electronic document and records management system (EDRMS) marketed by Micro Focus. Content Manager is an enterprise document and records management system for physical and electronic information designed to help businesses capture, manage, and secure business information in order to meet governance and regulatory compliance obligations.

SAFEQ users are now able to scan documents directly into Micro Focus Content Manager version 9.x following an update that was released in 6.0.57 and now we have added to this connectivity by allowing the SAFEQ administrator to scan the documents with metadata attached. (SQC-5592)



2 FIXES AND IMPROVEMENTS

2.1 TERMINALS, USER INTERFACES

Upon login to the Embedded Terminal for Sharp, the user will be presented with a clear and more visible 'Please Wait' message. (SBT-2734)

The SAFEQ web application is accurately displayed to the user on the HP LaserJet Ripken family. (SBT-2725)

Ricoh SOP scan successfully works with the latest releases. (SBT-2639)

On an HP MFD, any job that is cancelled by the user on the embedded terminal will be displayed in the waiting folder. (SBT-2457)

Upon logging into Embedded Terminal for Konica Minolta, the selected language will be correctly displayed. (SBT-2422)

2.2 INSTALLATION AND ADMINISTRATION

Submitted duplex jobs are successfully accepted, processed, and printed as duplex jobs. (SBT-2780)

In management when assigning an alias, if invalid characters are used then the user will be informed that the alias has not been saved. (SBT-2732)

When scheduling a web report to a file, the file name allows for a wider range of characters increasing the user-friendliness for different languages. (SBT-2731)

When scheduling a web report to a file, upon submitting a form, if an error occurs all values will be captured allowing the user to fix any issue and re-submit. (SBT-2719)

When scheduling a web report to a file, if the user enters invalid characters in the folder name, they will be informed what is wrong and can take clear action to resolve. (SBT-2718)

When running the server installer in multiple languages, the displayed text will be clear and easy to follow. (SBT-2713)

In management when selecting a billing code to assign to a user, upon making the selection the code will be displayed once and accurately reflect the selection. (SBT-2693)

Payment system successfully completes installation. (SBT-2677)

Microsoft Outlook jobs are successfully captured and displayed in both web reports and data mart. (SBT-2676)

In the counter reports screen in management, the calendar is successfully updated upon selecting the 'Go to today' button. (SBT-2535)

Location or description fields within the counter reports (management) correctly display the full text. (SBT-2489)

When selecting to upload a software package within the management web interface, the user will be informed of the outcome of the upload and any actions to take. (SBT-2485)

The administrator can now see or be informed of user management issues within the YPS payment system. (SBT-2466)

2.3 EARLY ACCESS PROGRAM

Within SAFEQ Client V3, the user can mark a print job as favorite without having to go to the MFD or web interface. (SQC-5248)

When the parser fails on job reception within SAFEQ Client V3, the jobs can be released on the printer. (SBT-2776)

In SAFEQ Client V3, the user can choose to navigate back to the Emergency Print screen from the dialogue box by selecting 'Back'. (SBT-2741)

When a user opens SAFEQ Client V3, and an error occurs due to connectivity issues, the user will be presented with an error message informing them that something has gone wrong and to try again. (SBT-2739)

YSoft SAFEQ Client v3 is under the Early Access Program (YSQL6-049-0000; YSoft SAFEQ Client v3; F_NEW_SQ6_CLIENT); see details about the program in Early Access Program. Client application use needs to be validated by a Y Soft Solution Consultant.
